ANALYSTS VIEW: GIDDY UP GIDLEIGH (7) has to manage an awkward barrier but couldn't have been more impressive winning a recent Canberra trial by almost 7L. He ran his best race before the spell and that would have him very competitive anyway. Expect the prominent local barn to have him primed. **IMPENDING HARMONY (6)** resumes for the top local stable and keep very safe. She was heavily backed at Wagga on debut but didn't finish it off on the heavy ground. She's sure to have come on and a bold run is likely. **FAIRNESS IS BEST (1)** just found one better here on debut racing handy and picking up impressively in the stretch. Draws ideally and with the extra fitness is a player. Bensley stays with him in preference to stablemate **VONK (3)** who followed a solid debut with a well-bet placing at the Sapphire Coast. He will be further improved and is also a hope.

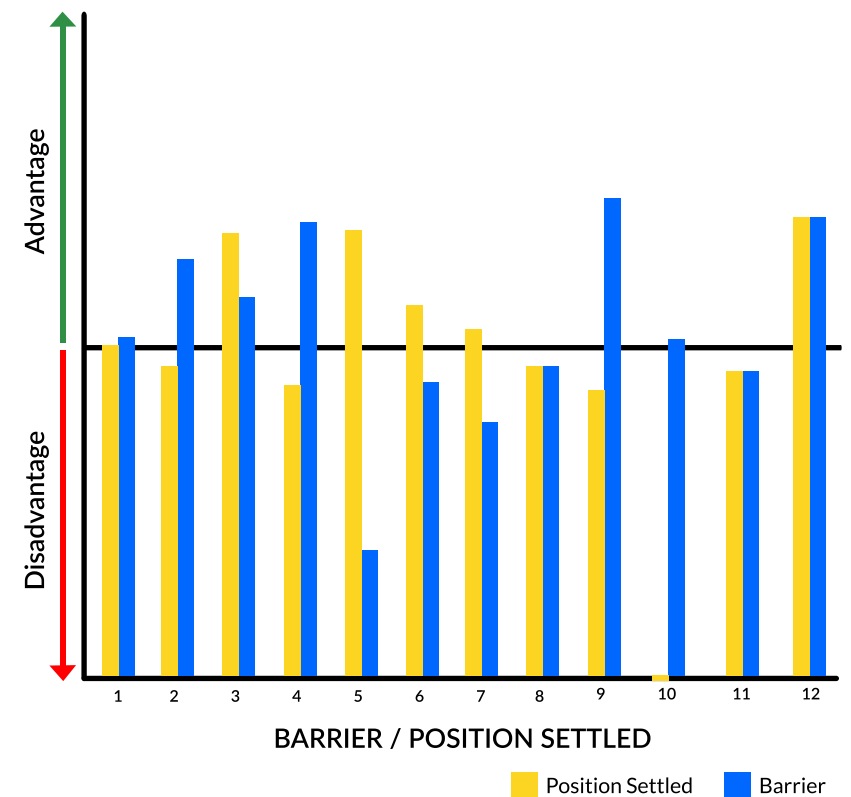
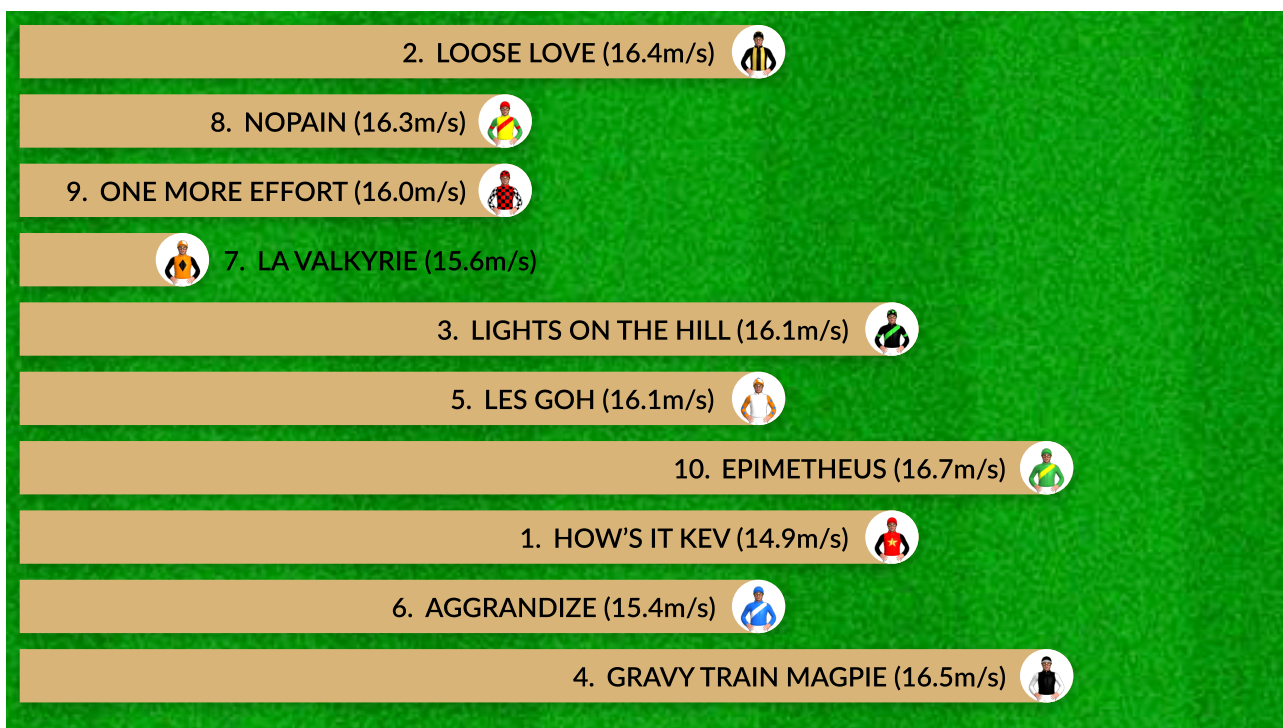

ANALYSTS VIEW: TROIKA (6) was okay resuming at Beaumont as favourite on the heavy and then got a dry surface at Goulburn and was an easy Maiden winner at short odds. Should secure the run of the race and can take the next step for the sharp Sydney barn. LONRIOLI (4) resumes and is also in good Sydney hands. Was in the market in Listed grade before the spell and demolished the Goulburn Maidens prior. She's trialed sharply at Rosehill and Clark is a key jockey booking. VINOLASS (9) resumes for the Dryden barn and won the Wagga Maiden comfortably on debut at a short quote. Will have come on and Dolan can use the rail. CHIEF CONDUCTOR (1) resumed in good order and is a second-up winner. She's in the mix. Lonrioli's stablemate SUCCESSFUL (7) can build on the surprise Maiden win here. Has a low gate and McEvoy is a positive jockey booking.

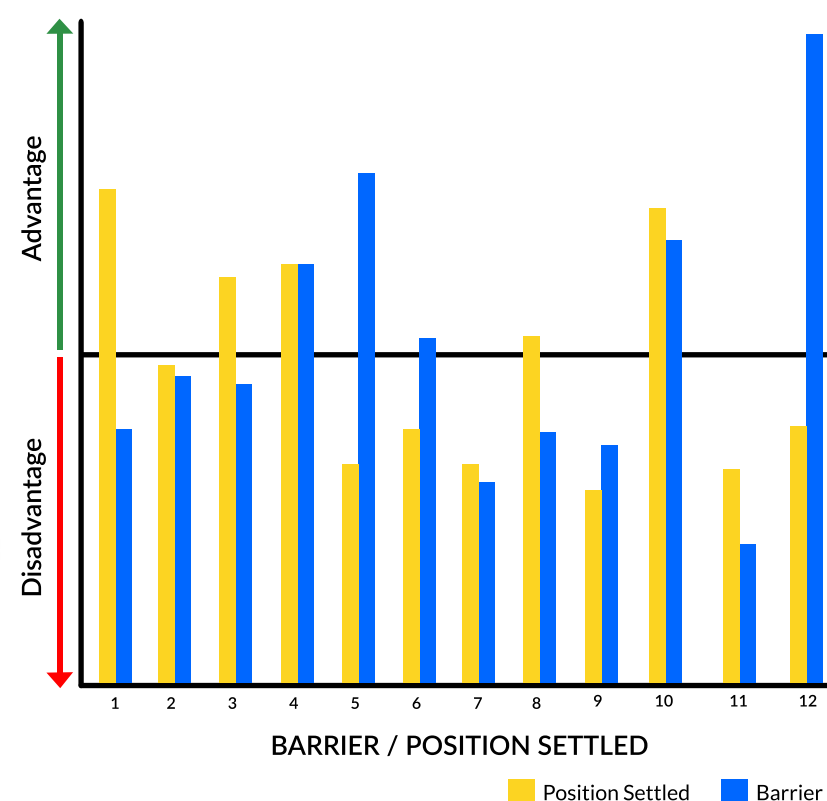


ANALYSTS VIEW: An even contest. **HOW'S IT KEV (1)** always puts in and missed 1.5L at Orange the latest bet 6-4. Draws for a soft run and Owen is a key jockey switch for the apprentice. Hard fit and gets the nod. GRAVY TRAIN MAGPIE (4) led and easily won the CL1 at Wagga bet off the map. Penza stays with the local and will use the rail again. Just has to see the mile right out. LES GOH (5) placed well beaten here 16-days ago behind a handy galloper who won in a breeze. Got up in the Maiden comfortably prior and is a local hope with the 1.5kg claim. LIGHTS ON THE HILL (3) would be a chance with a repeat of the Goulburn placing two-back. LOOSE LOVE (2) peaks and is going better than the form line suggests. He also deserves consideration.

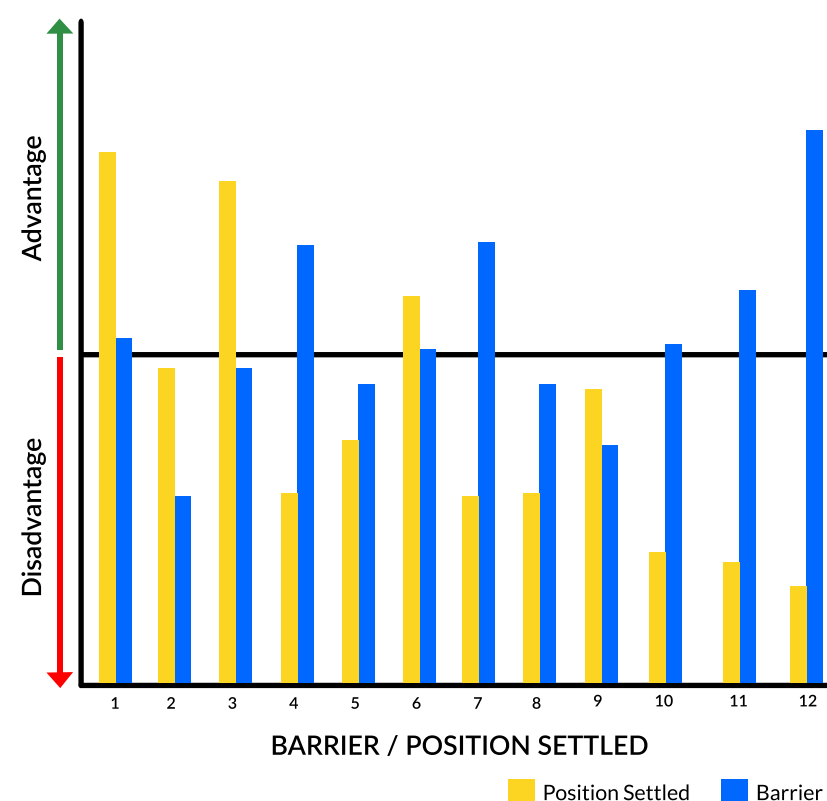

Draws awkwardly but will go close with average luck. **LOUIE'S LEGACY (1)** is third-up looking to make the hat-trick and gets in well with the 3kg claim. Draws for the run of the race and the local is a live chance. **BON FRANKIE (5)** was lipped out in the CL3 at Rosehill surprising the market. Was an easy Open winner in the bush prior and despite the awkward barrier shouldn't be underestimated. **DREAM INHERIT (6)** was a heavily bet CL1 winner here last time and should get the mile. **TWIG (4)** is another in the mix.

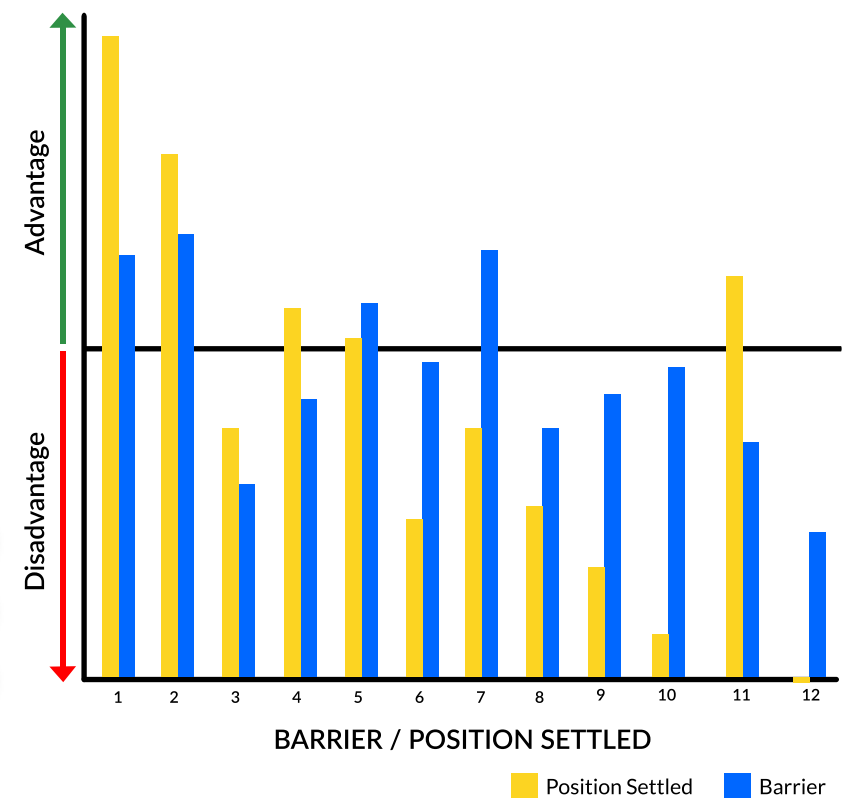
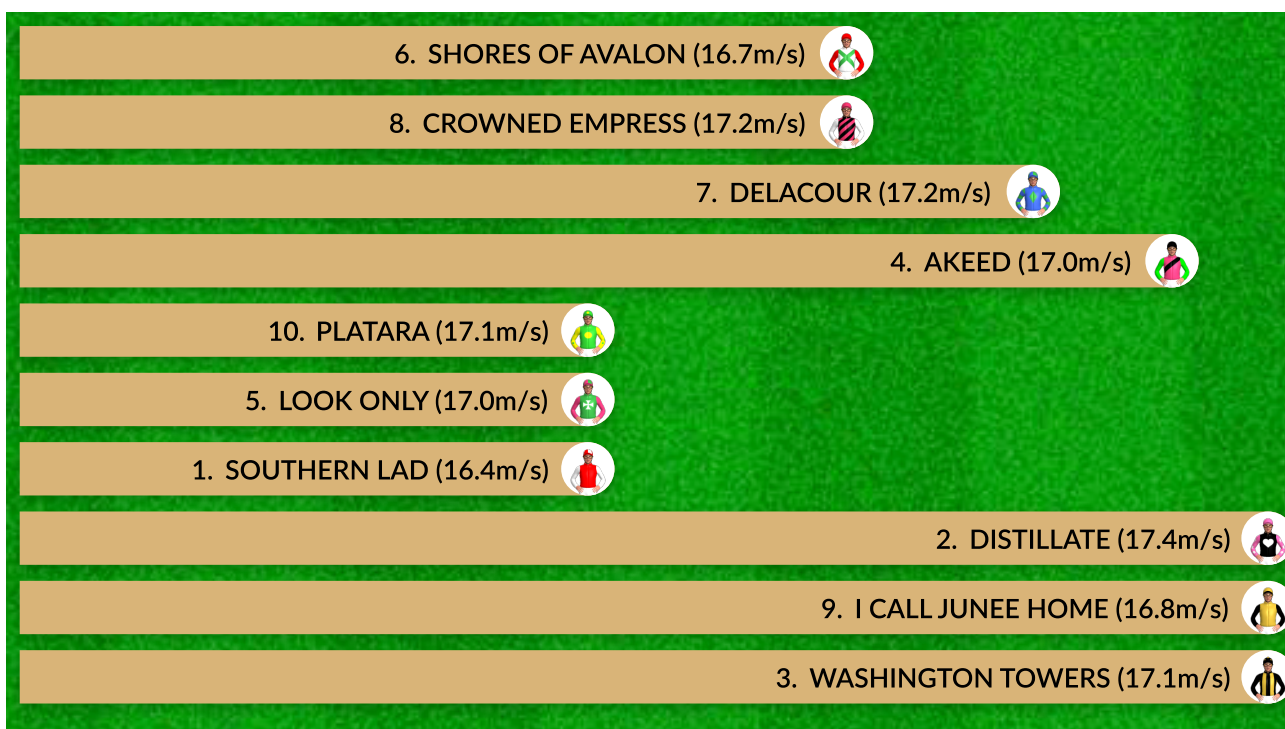

Rates strongly and can come back further improved. **RUBAN BLEU (2)** won the 70 here in an easy fashion and then disappointed as favourite at Wagga before bouncing back with a 1.5L defeat there in Open company bet 15-8. Penza stays with him and he can make the finish. **SKY DIAMONDS (4)** resumes for the leading local barn. The rail should benefit and she has a terrific record at this track. Her best last campaign came over further but expect her to be wound up for the big day. **LEMAIRE (1)** resumes and placed close-up in town both starts last preparation. Draws awkwardly but has the blinkers on again and is a chance with average luck in transit. **ZELAGO (11)** couldn't finish it off at Gosford but won and placed the two prior and is in the mix.

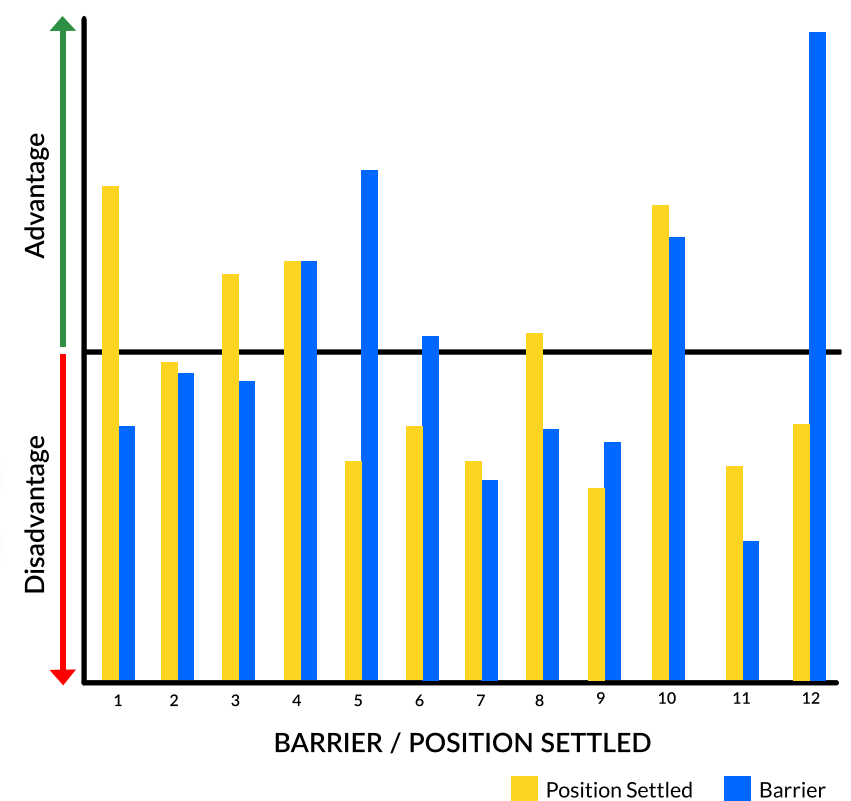

ANALYSTS VIEW: A good contest. DISTILLATE (2) is a leader who was beaten 1.5L at Canterbury first-up before winning the 72 at Randwick-Kensington. That's good form and she will run along from the low gate. In good hands and can bring up the double. AKEED (4) was an easy Open winner in the country and has threatened that grade the two since. Has been freshened and Penza is a key jockey switch. Races on speed and tipping he'll be very competitive. SHORES OF AVALON (6) has been busting to win in Opens and did a big job to place here the latest behind the impressive Super Helpful. Has an awkward gate but Dolan sticks and that's a plus. LOOK ONLY (5) was just nudged out in the same contest and lifted her figures again 4-days ago beaten a half-length at Randwick-Kensington in a 72. She's also a hope.

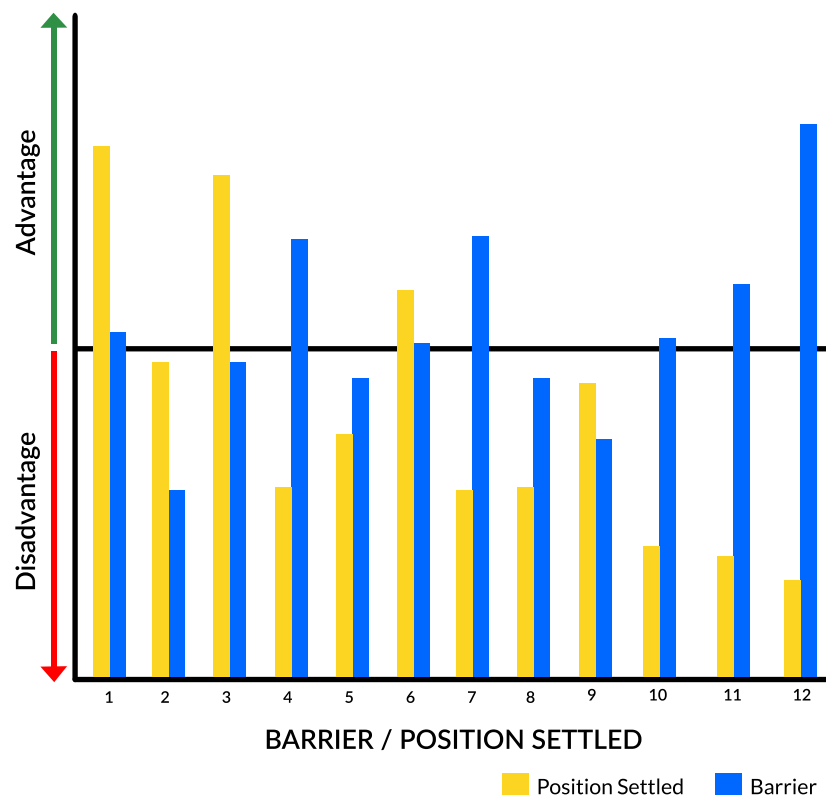


ANALYSTS VIEW: VRENELI (3) is in a top Sydney yard and brings the best figures. Two-back he missed a whisker in the Listed Carrington Stakes at Randwick and then jumped awkwardly there in an 88 and forgive. He's won a Rosehill trial since and is sure to take beating riding the speed. CAVALIER CHARLES (5) shapes as the danger. Won an 88 at Rosehill before the spell and was close up at Randwick resuming at the same level further improved. Fitter and Clipperton sticks. SAIGON (8) has been narrowly beaten her last two in city 78's and has been freshened by the Waller barn with a trial in between. Has an awkward gate but is sure to go well. SUPER HELPFUL (9) is a local coming off an impressive Open win here. Will be better for that and can get some of the money in tougher company.

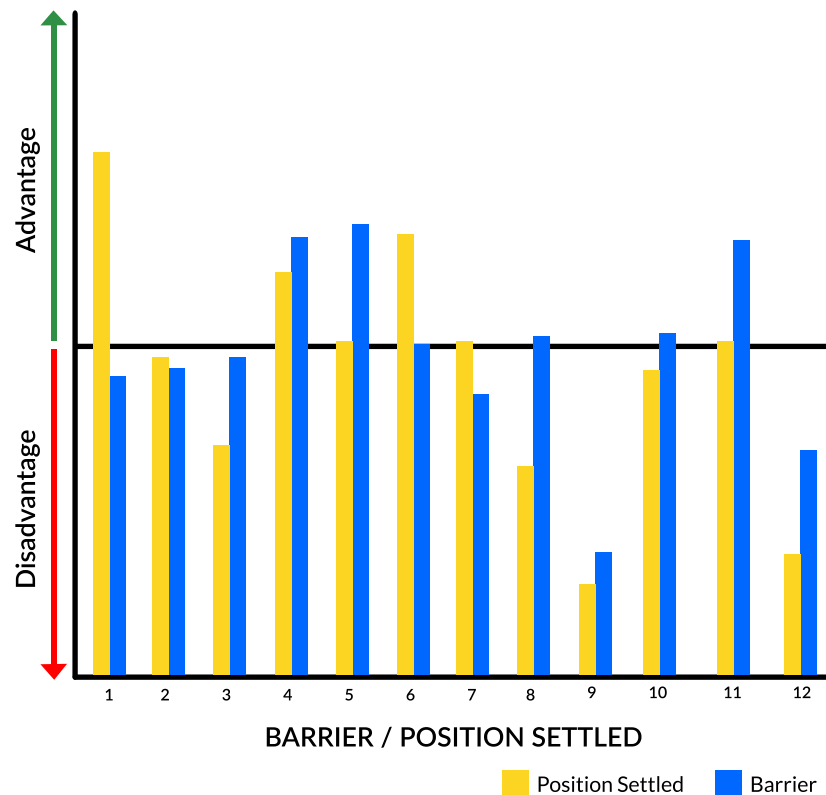


ANALYSTS VIEW: AUTUMN BALLE (14) debuts for Waterhouse-Bott owning a 7.6L Rosehill trial win. Stable favourite Clark sticks from that. She will push forward and will be hard to roll on what we've seen. Stablemate THE YEARS (4) brings a 5L Maiden win from Kembla Grange. This is a step-up but he's up-and-running and is a candidate to lead. TIZ INVINCIBLE (16) debuts for Maher-Eustace and looked the goods winning her latest trial. The in-form Michael Dee comes up from Melbourne to ride and that's a lead. Has an awkward gate that needs managing. MADEIRA SUNRISE (11) was hot in the mounting yard and put in a plain effort in the Group 2 Silver Slipper Stakes. Won the Listed Lonhro Plate prior on debut. Could provide the surprise if sorted. RAZORS (7) is in a top juvenile yard and will improve second up also at a price.

ANALYSTS VIEW: PICKO ROCKS (16) peaks off a string of provincial placings. Was a 6-4 favourite at Hawkesbury the latest and looks well placed by the Michael Freedman yard. DOMINGO (13) improved sharply second-up placing in town. That stacks up but he has a wide gate that requires a good McEvoy ride. SPITFIRE (3) continues to improve for Matt Dale and was narrowly beaten in a Randwick CL3 the latest. That would have him in the finish. BALINOR (12) has no rider declared but was good placing at Gosford on debut. Fitter and a chance if he takes his place. YARRAWONGA (5) resumes and is a former Irish galloper who's switched to Waterhouse-Bott after one run for a Victorian barn. It's an ask after 275 days away but he impressed his last run in Ireland over a staying trip and has had two trial warmers. Interests.
