One race only, and a one time opportunity to paddle along the City waterfront amongst the fanfare of the flotsam of boats on the harbour over the day. All teams are mixed regardless of make up.

Registration & Safety Check - 1100 hours Blessing - 1145 hours

Paddle round to Westhaven Tower – 1150 hours Race Start - I200 hours

RACE COURSE: (Course: 9 - 8.7nm)

Start/Finish Line: Westhaven Tower and the yellow Westhaven Outer Distance Mark. Head to; Ports of Auckland Buoy - yellow Orakei Buoy - yellow North Head Buoy - yellow Torpedo Buoy - red Rona Buoy (Birkenhead Wharf) – back to start line.
