Over the last 12 years, competitors have set course records in the W1 and W6 events. We are again offering prize money for these events.

Due to cases of hypothermia in previous IceBreaker Challenges, we will be making thermal clothing compulsory and checking that all competitors have adequate clothing before they are allowed to race.

RACE RULES

- ❖ **WAKA:** It is the responsibility of the club wishing to enter to arrange the use of eligible waka. Spray skirts are compulsory. Rudders optional for W1 waka.
- ❖ **SAFETY EQUIPMENT** - All W6 waka must carry two bailers, sufficient life jackets for all paddlers and two spare paddles. Depending on conditions, life jackets may be required to be worn by all competitors.
- ❖ **NOVICE CREWS** will have less than one year's paddling experience and may have an experienced steerer and one other experienced paddler; please respect this when entering the novice category. Lifejackets must be worn by novice paddlers.
- ❖ **COURSE** - A map of the course will be provided closer to the event. Race officials reserve the right to alter the course to suit conditions.
- ❖ **DRESS** - competitors must dress appropriately for colder conditions; polypropylenes recommended. Competitors will be checked to ensure they are dressed adequately for the conditions.
- ❖ **SAFETY** - the race director and officials have absolute control over the event. They have the discretion to withdraw any competitor or waka which in their opinion is or will be endangering their own or others' safety.
- ❖ **SUPPORT BOATS** - race organisers will arrange officials and support boats.

These are the terms and conditions for participation in the Icebreaker Regatta.

Participants agree to abide by the Rules in the Nga Kaihoe O Aotearoa Race Rules and accept all the risks of injury or damage to property and person that may arise from participation in the IceBreaker Regatta and understand that Fire in Ice Outrigger Canoe Club, their appointed officers, race officials and sponsors will not be held responsible whatsoever during the course of the day's racing.

We also agree that the race organisers will have the final decision on withdrawing our entry due to inadequate canoe equipment and/or the capabilities of the said crew paddlers. We understand that during the course of the race, the race officials may withdraw a team if in the officials' opinion it is considered that the crew is in danger or likely to be unable to complete the race.

The crew will be dressed appropriate for the conditions, must be confident swimmers and able to swim at least 50 metres.

Life jackets will be compulsory for all novice and junior events. Life jackets may be compulsory for all other competitors depending on weather conditions.

All persons participate at their sole risk. No organiser associated in any way with the regatta will be liable in any way or accept any responsibility for an injury, loss, damage or expense suffered or incurred by any participant during the racing or in any other way in connection with the participation of that person as a team member in the regatta.

I have read, understood and agree to the terms and conditions set out above, and as a condition of and in consideration for the entry and participation in the regatta I hereby (i) accept and agree to be bound by and observe the terms and conditions set out above and (ii) waive any claim or claims I may otherwise have against any one or more of the persons specified above, in respect of any injury, loss, damage or expense suffered or incurred by me during racing or in any other way in connection with my participation in the regatta.

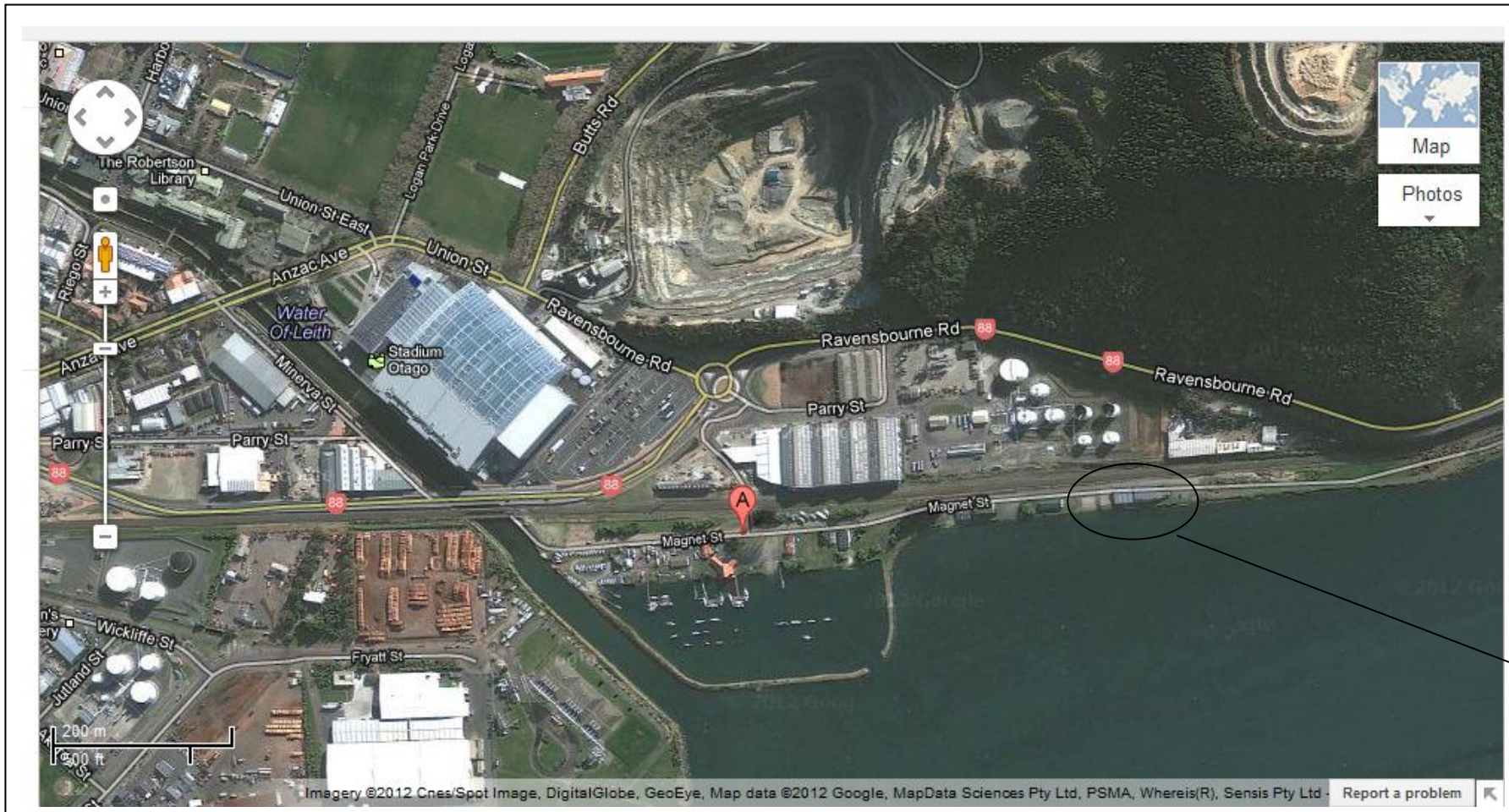
