Regional Category (12)	Criteria-strictly within the year 1st October 2016 to 30th September 2017 Nomination closes 20th November 2017 at 11.00pm
1. Sportsman	Exceptional performance on and off the water. Contribution to the growth of waka-ama. Demonstrates the values of waka ama. <i>Values listed after nomination form</i>
2. Sportswoman	Exceptional performance on and off the water. Contribution to the growth of waka-ama. Demonstrates the values of waka ama.
3. International Paddler	Has competed and achieved exemplary results in one or more international events in the given year. Having shared experiences on return will be an advantage.
4. International Team	A team comprising, or mostly comprising, members of one club in the AROCA Region. Has competed and achieved exemplary results in one or more international events in the given year. Having shared experiences on return will be an advantage.
5. National Paddler	Has competed and achieved exemplary results in one or more national events in the given year. Having shared experiences on return will be an advantage.
6. National Team	A team solely comprising members of one club in the AROCA Region. Has competed and achieved exemplary results in one or more national events in the given year. Having shared experiences on return will be an advantage.
7. Coach	Has coached teams or individuals that have performed well. The emphasis is on the <u>results</u> achieved by the people they have coached. It can also include a coach who has progressed inexperienced paddlers to the point where they have entered and performed in events for the first time, as much as results achieved by their elite paddlers. The nomination must include the facts on these results. In addition to all the factors that great coaches put into coaching.
8. Administrator	This must be a specific and measurable result. Reasons must be stipulated.
9. Supporter Award	This must be a specific and measurable. Reasons must be stipulated.
10. AROCA Club	For contribution to the growth and improvement of the region or other clubs in AROCA. May be nominated by your own club.
11. Sportsmanship Award	Awarded to an individual, team or club for commendable & consistent sportsmanship behaviour.
12. Premium Award	The premium Award will be determined from all of the received nominations.
