REGISTRATIONS

Online registrations are available at www.wakaama.co.nz and must be entered by your club representative. All paddlers competing in this event must be Waka Ama NZ affiliated paddlers. Registration fees:

\$90 Adult W6 (\$15 per paddler)

\$60 Junior W6 (\$10 per paddler)

\$10 W1/W2 (per paddler)

Junior paddlers: \$15 for both

Payment must be received into the account below by Wednesday 26 July 2017. No payment will be accepted on the day. It would be appreciated if clubs could make one deposit for all your entries. There will be no refunds for crews who choose not to race on the day.

SAFETY CHECKS

All safety checks need to be completed 15mins prior to racing. It is the teams' responsibility to ensure your waka is checked. We will not start the race until all are checked. If your waka is being used for multiple races you need to have another check between races. Spray skirts and life jackets are compulsory for all teams.

The Safety Waiver MUST BE SIGNED BY EACH CREW MEMBER. ALL steerers and W1/W2 paddlers MUST attend race briefing. This is an essential part of a paddler/team's safety check, so nonattendance means that a paddler/team will not be allowed to race.

REQUIRED SAFETY EQUIPMENT (W6)

- 1 x Cell phone in Waterproof Bag or Flare
- 2 x spare paddles
- 2 x bailers
- 1 x 25 30m Tow Rope attached to taumaunu Spray skirts
- Each paddler on board the waka must wear a life jacket. Junior paddlers are not permitted to wear PFDs.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Our race courses will be set within the boundaries of Napier Harbour between Sandy Beach, Perfume Point and Bay View.

The 12km novice race is designed for novice to semi-novice crews and steerer's. Entries are welcome for all W6 Male/Female/Mixed crews for this distance. Junior teams J19/J16 must have an experienced steerer/or have some experience to complete course. This course will also be used for

the W1 and W2 races.
