
Australian Jobs 2019 Occupation Matrix

Purpose

The 'Australian Jobs 2019' Occupation Matrix shows really useful details about roughly 350 different profession available in the Australian Labour Market, but the document itself can be difficult to read & understand – full of numbers. But with a little help, you can make sense of it!



Meanings of codes

Letter codes next to names of professions:

Кеу	Occupation
М	Managers
Р	Professionals
TT	Technicians and Trades Workers
СР	Community and Personal Service Workers
CA	Clerical and Administrative Workers
SW	Sales Workers
МО	Machinery Operator
L	Labourer

Median salaries:

Key	Median weekly earnings (before tax)
\$	Less than \$1,000
\$\$	\$1,001 - \$1,150
\$\$\$	\$1,151 - \$1,370
\$\$\$\$	\$1,371 - \$1,750
\$\$\$\$\$	More than \$1,750

Remember, these median weekly earnings are indicative only and should not be used to determine what a worker will actually earn.
