Students who have completed EAL will need to check the prerequisite study score. This document only covers prerequisites for domestic students and on-campus Bachelor level courses at Government funded universities. Please note there isn't a Unit 3-4 English study score prerequisite for nursing at Charles Sturt University for domestic students.
