Rural and remote students may be independent for Centrelink payments sooner

From 1 January, new students from rural and remote areas may be considered independent for the Centrelink payments Youth Allowance and ABSTUDY sooner. New students from a rural or remote area can be considered independent if they earn a certain amount of income after 14 months and meet other criteria. Right now, students have 18 months to earn the amount. Students still need to earn the same amount, just in a shorter period of time. Most eligible students will be able to start study sooner. If they're taking a gap year, they can begin study at the start of the school year. Some students may need to think about what the changes mean for them. Students can find out more about independence for Youth Allowance and ABSTUDY on the department's website. They can also contact the Department of Human Services to discuss their situation and options.
