Check in at <u>Sea Vu Caravan Park</u>, where you will experience direct access to the sandy beaches of Guichen Bay. Here you have the option of ocean-view cabins and powered sites. Nestled in the heart of town, this coastal retreat offers spectacular ocean views and a relaxed, welcoming atmosphere. Step outside your accommodation and feel the sea breeze as you take a short stroll to Robe's charming shops, cafes and restaurants. Whether you're waking up to the sound of the waves or winding down with a beachside sunset, Sea Vu is your perfect home away from home on the Limestone Coast. From here, your adventure begins.

If you're looking for alternative accommodation options:

- <u>Little Dip Conservation Park Campgrounds</u> offer a rugged coastal escape just south of Robe. With four campgrounds to choose from, you can enjoy birdwatching, lakeside walks and beach activities.

Nothing says indulgence like a Southern Rock Lobster platter from <u>Sky Seafoods</u>. While your freshly caught feast is being prepared, take a behind-the-scenes tour of the live lobster processing factory, where you'll see lobsters cohabitating in the tanks and learn how they are expertly processed - either live or cooked. Once your platter is ready, pair it with a local wine or craft beer and make your way to the Robe Jetty. Here, as you savour the delicate flavours of the sea, you'll be treated to panoramic views of Guichen Bay - a perfect moment to slow down, breathe in the salty air and soak in the magic of this coastal escape.

AFTERNOON OFF-ROAD ADVENTURE & COASTAL THRILLS

With the taste of the ocean still lingering, it's time to embrace the untamed beauty of <u>Little Dip Conservation Park</u>. Buckle up and set off on a thrilling <u>4WD adventure</u>, navigating rugged coastal tracks that wind through towering dunes, limestone cliffs and secluded beaches. For those self-driving, pick up a 4WD guide and tide times chart from the Robe Visitor Centre before you set off, or if you prefer a local guide, contact <u>Robe 4x4 Back Beach Adventure Tours</u> for a half day tour or tag along style adventure. Along the way, discover a landscape shaped by time - tranquil lakes, coastal mallee and ancient shell middens offering glimpses into the region's Indigenous heritage. Keep an eye out for Hooded Plovers and native wildlife, as you explore this diverse and breathtaking wilderness, where every turn reveals another spectacular view.

The adventure doesn't stop there - Stony Rise beckons. Whether you're riding legendary waves or watching the surf roll in, this surf break offers the perfect dose of adrenaline and awe-inspiring beauty. Cool off with a snorkel in the rock pools, where you'll experience an underwater world teeming with life.



EARLY EVENING CRAFT BREWS & LOCAL FLAVOURS



After a day of sun and salt, it's time to unwind with local flavours. Head to <u>Robe Town Brewery</u>, the only wood-fired brewery in Australia, where you'll discover a range of unique, handcrafted beers brewed using old-school, low-tech methods. Relax in the brewery's vibrant venue, offering a great selection of beers to taste and take away, along with local wines and other beverages. Pair your drink with award-winning <u>Mike's Beef Jerky</u> for the perfect post-adventure snack. Not into beer? Try a locally crafted <u>Robe Gin</u> cocktail for a refreshing twist. With live music and regular events, Robe Town Brewery is the place to soak in the best vibes of the coast.

ICONIC SUNSET & DINNER

No trip to Robe is complete without witnessing the sunset at the iconic Robe Obelisk. Perched on the cliffs, this historic landmark provides a front-row seat to the sky's golden display, making it a romantic and awe-inspiring moment to share.

As night falls, indulge in a premium dining experience at <u>Sails at Robe</u> Restaurant. With a menu featuring fresh seafood, premium cuts and local produce, every bite is a celebration of the region's finest flavours.



DAY 2 - COASTAL WONDERS & OUTDOOR FUN

BEACHSIDE BREAKFAST

Wake up to the scent of the ocean and the anticipation of another unforgettable day. Start with a flaky, buttery croissant and expertly brewed coffee from The Pastry Place Robe, a local and visitor's favourite. Take a leisurely stroll along Long Beach, letting the soft sand warm your toes and the waves create a soothing soundtrack to your morning.



LIMESTONE COAST BOAT TOUR



The call of the ocean awaits! Departing from Lake Butler Marina, embark on a <u>Limestone Coast Boat Tours</u> adventure, where the wild beauty of Guichen Bay unfolds before you (be sure to prebook this prior to arrival). Cruise past the sweeping sands of Long Beach before heading to Godfrey Island (Baudin Rocks), home to Australian Sea Lions and Long-nosed Fur Seals. Watch as they bask in the sun, frolic in the shallows, or swim curiously up to the boat for a closer look. In summer, you may even spot playful bottlenose dolphins gliding through the waves. Throughout the journey, seabirds like Gannets and Cormorants soar overhead. To finish, take in the stunning offshore view of the Robe Obelisk, standing defiantly against the elements—a picture-perfect ending to your ocean adventure.

If the weather doesn't allow for a boat tour, head to Jumbo's Landing at Lake Battye for a kayak or standup paddle board adventure. <u>Stillwater Paddleboards</u> do tours, or you can hire equipment through <u>Inflate Kayak Hire</u>.

COASTAL BIKING ADVENTURE

Back on land, the adventure continues with a <u>TRACX</u> Mountain Bike Tour along Robe's stunning coastal trails. Feel the rush of salty air as you ride along rugged cliffs and past pristine beaches, immersing yourself in Robe's natural beauty.

The best part? The tour is tailored to your experience level, ensuring you're challenged, yet comfortable as you explore at your own pace. Over 1.5 to 2 hours, you'll journey along scenic, less-travelled paths, making stops for photo opportunities and local insights about Robe's unique geographic icons.

Whether you're a seasoned rider or new to mountain biking, this customisable experience is a perfect way to connect with nature, each other and the breathtaking landscape. Finish your tour with a well-deserved morning tea at one of Robe's charming cafes.



FAREWELL LATE LUNCH AT THE CALEDONIAN INN
