OUTPATIENT GLA

Triage and Testing Updated 6/24/2020

ANY: Subjective fevers, or chills, fever >99.9F, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, trouble breathing, body/muscle aches, diarrhea, severe fatigue OR a constellation of less-specific symptoms (e.g. headache, new loss of taste or smell)



Optional Testing

Test for COVID19 with appropriate PPE upon patient request*

* While testing should not be denied to anyone, it is particularly relevant for persons with possible COVID-19 exposures or who live or work in a group setting (e.g. nursing home, homeless shelter, etc.). Testing is most accurate 4-7 days after exposures.



Put on a surgical mask on patient and move to appropriate isolation area. Follow PPE guidance for suspected COVID.

Test for COVID19 with appropriate PPE and give instructions for home isolation*
