Triage and Testing Updated 4/23/2020

ANY: Subjective fevers/chills, fever >99.9F, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, trouble breathing, body/muscle aches, diarrhea, severe fatigue OR a constellation of less-specific symptoms (e.g. headache, new loss of taste or smell)



Lives or works in a group setting (e.g. nursing home, homeless shelter, etc.) AND close contact with known COVID positive person OR patients of a respiratory illness outbreak (upper or lower) in last 3 days?

Put on a surgical mask on patient and move to appropriate isolation area. Follow PPE guidance for suspected COVID.

SEVERE symptoms requiring hospitalization?





Inpatient P.U.I.

Start enhanced droplet precautions.
Test for COVID19 with proper PPE.

- Underlying medical condition (chronic lung disease, moderate to severe asthma, serious heart condition, immunosuppressed, BMI >40, diabetes, or liver disease)?
- **Dialysis** patient?
- Patient needing to enter GLA facility to receive urgent medical care (e.g. chemotherapy)?

Test for COVID19 with proper PPE and give instructions for home isolation*.

*If the patient is a veteran living in the domiciliary, living in the on-campus nursing home (CLC), Cal Vets, or is homeless, contact ID for possible admission to the hospital. Patients that are unable to care for self at home should also be considered for admission.

Suspected COVID NO TEST

Testing unlikely to change management. Follow LA County instructions for home quarantine for patients with respiratory symptoms.
