	Low back pain and suspected cauda equina syndrome (e.g., bowel or bladder sx, weakness in legs)
Allergy	Severe allergic reaction (e.g., angioedema, airway or breathing complaints)
Endocrine	Symptomatic and FSG < 70 DKA
Ob-Gyn	Unstable ruptured ectopic pregnancy  Abdominal pain/vaginal bleeding with pregnancy ≥ 20 weeks

Identified exclusion criteria requires initiation of medical screening exam and notification of attending physician to assist in determining appropriate location of care.
