If you have read Percy Jackson and The Olympians series written by Rick Riordan, you will be familiar with many creatures and monsters that appear in this series. Some creatures help Percy and his friends while others are not so helpful.

One creature in particular is my favourite. He helps Percy, who is a demigod and a son of a Greek God. He is Percy's best friend and a protector.

If you have already not guessed, the name of this character is Grover Underwood.

Grover Underwood is a Satyr. Satyrs appear in Greek mythology as half humans and half goats. They have human upper bodies and legs and horns of a goat in lower bodies.

Grover is also one of the main characters in this famous series. His job is to discover demigods and bring them to camp Half- blood.

Grover has some nice characteristics. He is loyal to his friends and always tries to defend them. He helps Percy in all his quests. He has an empathy link with Percy which means if one dies, the other will die too. He also helps Percy's other friends in every way he can.

Grover handles dangerous situations well. At the same time, he can get scared quite easily. He is terrified of cyclops, the one-eyed giants. He is also afraid of rabbits. He can talk to animals and likes helping them too.
