1. Purpose

Fees Policy

The YMCA is a not-for-profit organisation. The operation of our Education and Care services are financed through the collection of fees from account holders, primarily the participants' parent or guardian. As the financial operation of these services operate under a number of Federal Laws that pose significant penalties for non-compliance, this Policy and Standard Operating Procedure guides YMCA services in the accurate, timely and legally compliant financial administration to ensure each services' financial viability, meet legal obligations and permit future growth of Children's Services programs.

2. Scope

The scope of this Policy applies to all Board members, Sub Committee members, educators, and volunteers. This Policy applies to all YMCA Member Associations. For the purposes of this document, we refer to these as the YMCA. All Policies and Procedures must conform to this Policy.

3. Policy Statement

For the payment of fees by parents/guardians as required. For services eligible for Child Care Subsidy to remain compliant with Family Assistance Law.

Management	Ensure the YMCA Payment of fees and provision of a statement of fees policy is implemented in their workplace. Management will ensure that upon enrolment families understand their financial responsibilities and all processes and expectations are communicated effectively. Management will ensure that families do not build a debt that is a financial burden on their family unit by monitoring debts and
	adhering to this policy.
Families	Families must ensure that they fulfil their fee payment obligations and provide their banking details prior to their child starting care as required.
