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### **PLAYING RULES, REGULATIONS & CONDITIONS**

To ensure each team is aware of the competition rules, regulations and conditions; team contacts are required to read all the information below. Please initial in the required locations and sign at the bottom of the form.

#### **Player Conduct:**

• The Port Lincoln Leisure Centre encourages fair play. Never argue with an official. If you disagree, have your captain approach the official after the completion of the game.

#### **Team Nominations:**

• The Program Coordinator has the right to accept or reject any nomination received. Should nominations exceed space available places will be allocated on a fist in basis although existing teams get first preference.

#### Registration of Players:

- Only players with complete details on the registration form including Full Name, Parent / Guardian Name, D.O.B., and Contact Number will be accepted.
- Any additional players who play throughout the season must ensure that their full details are filled out on a player registration form in order to be registered and eligible for finals.
- Minimum age for senior competition is 15 years of age irrespective of sporting ability.

#### **Duties of thew Team Captain:**

- The team captain (and their guardian as on nomination form) agrees to be personally liable for any fine that may be imposed upon the team as a result of the team forfeiting a game or withdrawing from the competition.
- The team captain is responsible for ensuring all game fees are paid and that game starts on time.
- The team captain is responsible to ensure all players are following the by-laws, codes of conduct and terms and conditions of the facility and the programs.

#### Team Sheet Fee:

- Senior Match Fee \$35.00.
- Teams must pay in full prior to the beginning of every game.

#### Umpire/Referee:

- It is the Team Capatins responsibility to supply a referee (Futsal) or umpire (Netball).
- Failure to supply a competent scorer will result in the team having no right of complaint in regards to the score.

#### Forfeit Fees:

All teams must notify Port Lincoln Leisure Centre as early as possible if your team has to forfeit. Each time the team forfeits, the fine shall be \$35 (same as a match fee). If a team gives a week's notice, the forfeit fine will not apply. (Premiership points will not be rewarded whilst forfeit fees are outstanding). This fee is a seasonal fee and is not refundable at any stage during the season. Forfeits will not come out of your nomination fee and will need to be paid before the start of the next match. Not paying the forfeit fine before your next scheduled match may result in a \$25 late fee.

Un-notified forfeit is a forfeit where the team either does not contact staff regarding a forfeit or calls after 12pm on match day. This will be a \$100 fine, and will need to be paid before the start of the next scheduled match.

If the team forfeits 3 times during the season or 2 games in a row management has the right to remove you from the competition.

#### Season Fixture:

 All teams should expect an even spread of time slots over the season. Teams can request earlier or later games prior to program creation by contacting the program coordinator.

#### **Uniform Rules:**

Due to Covid19 restrictions unfortunately teams will be required to provide their own bibs or team shirts with Identifying positions.

- Players must wear a similar shade of colour top.
- Closed in shoes must be worn by ALL players.
- Shin guards must be worn by ALL FUTSAL players.
- Facial piercings must be covered with brown tape; no other jewelery is permitted on court.
- Tape or nail scissors will not be supplied by Port Lincoln Leisure Centre and is the responsibility of the team.

#### Late Team Entry:

• Late teams cannot be guaranteed immediate entry into the competition and their grade will be dependent on availability.
